5. Unfinished Business:

A. Animal Control Officer and Knox County: Selectman Daniel Staples reported that he has talked with Tim Carroll from the Knox County Sheriffs Office. Beginning the first of the year the sheriffs office should be ready to take over the animal control position. Selectman Laurie Haynes inquired if it will save the town money. Selectman Daniel Staples said the cost should be the same but coverage should be much better. He said that the sheriffs office feel they can get the animal care facility fee reduced. He said that in the written agreement Cushing will be able to pull out at anytime if the board feels it isn't working for Cushing.

Selectman Laurie Haynes inquired what is planned for road work in the coming year because she has had a complaint. A resident has a large vehicle that due to several bad places in the road it is being damaged when they drive on Spear Mill Road. Selectman Laurie Haynes went to check it out and thought that there was a culvert problem. Chairman Alton Grover didn't know exactly where she meant so he asked Selectman Haynes to show him and she said she would.

Chairman Alton Grover noted that if there is any money in the spring that the town will plan to hot top the area on Spear Mill Road next year to try and fix the issue.
