1. Call to Order: Chair Alton Grover called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M. and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

2. Approve and Sign the Warrant:

4. Other Business:

Selectman Staples noted that the minutes just approved mentioned a discussion of perhaps not meeting on Memorial Day. Selectman Haynes said it should be skipped if there was nothing pressing for that date.

ACTION: Selectman Daniel Staples made a motion, seconded by Selectman Laurie Haynes, that we not meet on May 26th and reconvene at the first meeting in June.

5. Unfinished Business:

A. Public Water Access: Selectman Staples said there were no updates on this issue, but the Harbor Committee was looking into a place on Maple Juice Cove.

B. Spear Mill Wood Furnace: Chair Grover said he had asked the Code Officer to go look at the wood furnace about which neighbors were complaining. CEO Bickford had said the furnace was used to heat the home and water and there were no laws governing this, so nothing could be done. An ordinance would be the only solution, but who would enforce it? Selectman Haynes said she would not want an ordinance for that unless people got up a petition.

6. Adjournment:

ACTION: Selectman Robert Worthing made a motion, seconded by Selectman Daniel Staples, to adjourn at 6:10 P.M.
