**5a. Salt Pond jake break**

**Discussion:** The selectboard received a letter of complaint of “jake braking” going on on Salt Pond Road. The letter asked if the town could kindly put signs at both ends of the road stating “NO JAKE BRAKING, on that windy road the speed should be limited to heavy duty trucks and the use of jake breaks makes the environment extremely noisy.” Danny said that jake brakes are used to slow the trucks down, and second who is going to put the signs up and enforce them. Danny thinks that they need to have an ordinance of some kind to do this. Craig felt that we would need an ordinance that would prohibit jake braking and if we do it for one road are we going to have to do it for all the others. Danny said he would like to ask other towns what they do for this.

### **6a. Sand and Salt Shed**

#### **ACTION:**

**Discussion-** Danny said the door is all up and the sand and salt are coming tomorrow and being put in Thursday. Danny said there is one set back on the door, there is two eye beams they put them in down low on the floor. There are complications to that come along with that. Danny had Miller and Miller come take a look at it to see what they would do. They came up with a scenario to make it work. It would take about 15minutes for them to come fix it. The board wanted to know if there is any warranty to the door. Danny is going to call Overhead Door company.

## **7. New Business:**

### **7a. Rescue Squad request**

#### **ACTION:**

**Discussion-** Cheryl said that she attended the meeting the other night and was informed that the garage door remote was not working properly or in a timely manner. They received the remote from PDQ. Andy Blanchard said that they need to have somebody come down to look at the garage door and see what the matter is. Cheryl said that she can call PDQ for them and see if they have any recommendations for that. Andy gave a letter out to the selectboard of things that are going on in the Ambulance department and things that he would like to see happen with the department. Andy said the biggest concern you would see on there is the pay scale. The department started talking first about the Director and assistant Director stipend which is low compared to other towns, even though they are a volunteer-based department. He stated all the responsibilities of a volunteer-based department are just as much as a full-time service department. Andy said the director pay was low looking into the other towns. He was hoping to raise that up a little bit. Danny said that this would have to go into there budget and be voted on at the Town Meeting. Andy said that they are adding a lieutenant position. Andy said along with this he is re-writing the bylaws. He said once he gets his rough draft written up, it would be a good idea for the lawyer to look at. This position would be starting somebody at the bottom and train them into being a director or an assistant director. Andy said they have not had a raise in over 10 years. An "on call pay" would be added as well. This would be \$3 an hour pay. Danny stated that he has absolutely no problem with anything that Andy has presented. Cheryl said that she was very impressed on hearing at the meeting that Cushing Ambulance has not had a call that they have not responded too as a volunteer department. Andy said they are looking into purchasing some new equipment that he would like to be paid through

the ARPA Funds, that are required to be on the truck. He will investigate prices and come back to the board with those.
